1-CLICK RESUME

SUGGESTIONS

- Urging for prompts in all areas on resume, clarity needed
- likes a resume which is a simple & clean resume with one column
- Should include important details of length and year internships be
- would love if action words could be highlighted and if it could say how good the job descriptions are
- wanted to know what recruiters want to see
- help with tailoring resume to different job applications

EXPERIENCES

- help with word usage and how to write concisely (1 page limit)
- revises resume after gaining new experiences or skills
- resume update harder than resume maintenance
- used resume templates from family or school
- job descriptions are difficult to write as it needs to be personalized and adding those action verbs key words to the job description
- area = general category skill = specific focus
- struggles to write good bullet points/ job responsibilities
- edits resume right before applying to new job
- Use bullet points not paragraphs, easier for recruiters
- does not use colorful or elaborate resume templates
- struggle to maintain professional tone in resume
- "intimidated" at being asked to fill out large blank spaces
- difficult to find a good Resume format
- gets nervous while creating/ thinking about resume as it is the foundation
- entering information about yourself is easy

SECTIONS

TECHNICAL SKILLS

- Feels the need for technical areas and technical skills are irrelevant
- technical skills difficult to ideate
- difference between tech area vs. skills clearer than soft area vs. skills
- Believes project management is not a skill but a tech area
- Instead of listing projects under skills should only list skills
- did not really understand what the technical skills showed (visual showing)
- When faced with tech information, requested further context
- technical skills = less projected and can be counted soft skills can be measured
- was not really sure on how to differentiate between technical skills and technical areas

SOFT SKILLS

- Feels the need for soft areas and soft skill are irrelevant
- struggled to define soft skills
- soft skills difficult to ideate
- soft area & soft skill not so intuitive
- Requesting better prompt when asking for soft skills as it is very general topic
- Unclear of difference between soft areas vs. skills
- remove soft "areas" vs. "skills," keep them all skills
- While tech skills help you do your work, soft skills help you do that work with people in a team
- Overall finds difficulty in the addition of areas soft/tech also frameworks
- does not put soft skills in the resume, finds it useless
- soft skills = personality like leadership
- soft area = main area and than soft skill related to that industry

PROG LANG/ FRAMEWORKS

- did not know what frameworks are
- prog lang and technical skills hard to differentiate
- Frameworks aren't as important as languages
- unsure what frameworks are
- unsure of what frameworks are

HIGHLIGHTS

- Awards are redundant with achievements
- Feels that highlights and education are pretty good and everything needed to fit out a tree
- personal emphasis on "experience" section than technical skills
- Finds highlights slightly irrelevant although adds to user personality
- achievements and awards hard to differentiate
- confused on whether they can include outside experiences
- unclear of how/what to highlight (skills or experiences)
- suggestions for skill highlights according to job app
- wanted more emphasis on achievements
- struggled to succinctly summarize experiences

FEATURES

POSTS/TAGS

- unclear how posts features links to participant's usage on the platform
- less involvement with STEM-Away = less understanding of posts and tags
- instead of linking the post it can be described

BARVOTING

- did not understand barvoting system
- unsure about validation system usage for participants
- did not understand what was being done and why they were doing it for example feel no ownership
- thought validation bar represents total personal posts divided by all posts of forums
- using is confusing but represents what is meant to be done on the platform
- confused about what votes mean/do
- was not sure why the post with 0 votes was shown
- Green bar shouldn't be in soft skills, so it is 'subjective'
- The leveled bar/level is much more preferable than green bar
- Green bar link like represents not green bar link like person experienced in skill
- Green bar link like represents not green bar link like more angry than green
- Green Bar makes no sense whether depend on votes or posts

SUGGESTIONS

- wants to see 1-CR examples
- 1-CR should be simple and quick to develop
- 1-click = all resources for building available in one place
- want to use previous resume to build new 1-CR
- wants banner to represent user interests
- privacy mode when editing resume (public viewing all the time)
- don't keep posts section twice (top section & nav bar)
- wanting more clickable features on the platform
- clarification on how to fill out each section
- Believes 1-cl resume - benefits from exploring links and one leaf
- even better would be a drop down menu with tags, less stressful
- want examples of each section
- want a preview of what the resume looks like after all the information is compiled
- doesn't like that when there are drop down menus with no suggestion list
- 1-click = you enter your info and everything is formatted for you in a resume
